

Animal Feed

The most important thing about the flavors used in animal feed/food is that the flavored food fed to the animals smells good to the farmer and housewife. They are the first ones to evaluate the flavored foods. If they like the flavor, they think the animal will also like it.

Livestock are fairly selective in what they like. Dairy animals like sweet flavors: vanilla, caramel, butter, apple and juicy fruit types.

Pigs are much more selective than other livestock. They have very definite likes and dislikes. When pigs are weaned, most of them do not accept cow milk or other feeds for 2-3 weeks. As a result, many die and many lose weight during this period. It is of most importance that we supply a flavor, added to cows milk that the piglets will accept right away.

This is the reason we developed our cow's milk replacer. Other flavors that pigs like are maple, caramel, butterscotch and milk cream types.
